



FIVE EASY WAYS TO HELP SUPPORT CVCS!

CVCS Web Marketplace

When you shop online through our Web Marketplace, a percentage of the purchase cost is sent to CVCS, without affecting the amount you pay. To use the Web Marketplace:

1. Use your web browser to go to <http://www.cottonwoodvalley.org/marketplace/> (You can bookmark this page for future use.)
2. Browse through our list of online merchants (we have almost all the major ones) and click on the one you wish to visit. This sets a “cookie” in your browser to let the merchant know that you arrived at their site via the CVCS link.
3. If you find what you are looking for, purchase the product as usual, and CVCS will be sent a percentage of the price at no cost to you. There is also a Google search link.

Friends and family elsewhere in the U.S. can also start their shopping through our Web site to help support our school, so be sure to let them know.

Labels for Education



CVCS participates in the Labels for Education program. If you use any products that have the Labels for Education logo on them (e.g., Campbell's, Pepperidge Farm, V8), clip the point coupons and turn them in at the CVCS office. Box Tops for Education



CVCS participates in the Box Tops for Education program. If you purchase products that have the Labels for Education logo on them (e.g., Cheerios, Betty Crocker, Pillsbury, Ziploc, Kleenex, Hefty), clip the coupons and turn them in at the CVCS office. CVCS can redeem the coupons for cash.

Used Printer Cartridges

Bring your used printer cartridges (ink jet, laser printer, etc.) to the CVCS office. We can redeem them for in-store credit (\$3.00 per cartridge!) at Office Max.
