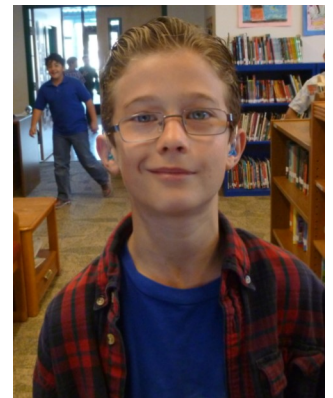
Congratulations to 5th grader Radeen Moradi for his 3rd place medal at last week's Chess Tournament at NMT!
