Please read the attendance policy in the new handbook your child brought home last week. The attendance policy has changed from last year, and it is important that you be aware of these changes. Please call the office if you have any questions.

The early release day on Wednesday, October 8 has been cancelled, and the new early release date is Wednesday, October 15.

The original date was cancelled because October 8, 2014 is the 40th day of school, and this is a very important date on a school's calendar because the attendance count on this date determines much of a school's funding.
